....The Hamilton Clermont Cooperative

- A **public entity**
  - Established in 1980 via Ohio Revised Code authorizing the creation of public data sites throughout Ohio. One of 18 similar sites throughout Ohio.
- A **collaborative of public entities**
  - Some things are done better together than separately.
- Provides **effective, cost-efficient services**, coupled with **superior client support**.
  - Accounting, Payroll, Student Administration, Electronic Grade Books, Library Automation, Professional Development, Internet Access, Technical/Network Support, Telephony, State reporting to the ODE, and more.
- To a variety of **organizations**
  - public school districts, community schools, educational service centers, nonpublic schools, governmental entities, higher ed, other ITC, and others.

# Today's Big Ideas

- Cyber security seeks to manage **organization-wide risk** that includes, but is much broader than, technology.
- Control and alignment of the functions and resources required to manage organization-wide risk are the **responsibility of the organization's CEO and CFO**.
  - risk assessment, policies, procedures, staffing, training, budgeting, insurance, legal, resource allocation, and more.

### Hamilton Clermont Cooperative move lowers costs, improves services




#### HCC becomes the first Ohio Information Technology Center to move facilities to the SOCC

*Columbus, Ohio (Feb 7, 2017)* — One of Ohio's regional Information Technology Centers (ITC) has cut operational costs while maintaining high availability to its customers by moving its network services to a centralized location in Columbus.

The Hamilton Clermont Cooperative (HCC) worked for eight months with the Ohio Academic Resources Network (OARnet) to move its network operations to the State of Ohio Computer Center (SOCC), a project that was completed in June 2016.

HCC is the first ITC in Ohio to move all of its facilities to the SOCC. The SOCC provides HCC with a disaster recovery site, redundancy and secure data storage. HCC Director of IT Services Adam Blevins said the SOCC's recent power and redundancy upgrades, as well as its proximity to other state agencies, were contributors to the decision to move.

"It just makes sense," Blevins said. "Public agencies serving other public agencies ... the public dollar just works more efficiently."



# What HCC is doing for you.

## Cyber-Collaboration Across the State

*Some things are better done together....*

- Working with the Attorney General and Auditor of State, fellow ITC, and others, on **state-level initiatives** of current or potential benefit to you
- Part of statewide **ITC Security Working Group**, creating and implementing **common security controls** and the use of **common security tool sets** across ITCs
- Working with fellow ITC and MCOECN to reaching out to major **cyber liability** carriers to obtain policy information for ITCs ....and YOU.

# What HCC is doing for you.


## **Cyber Security**

- Email filtering – using state and local resources
- Firewall protection and web filtering via iBoss
- Traffic analysis for suspicious activity
- Aligning HCC processes and practices to NIST standards
- Cyber liability insurance – applications sent, bids forthcoming
- IT staff - advanced training and professional development
  - Hope to make available to area tech personnel soon!

# What HCC is doing for you.

## Strengthening Cyber Security

- Investigating **Open DNS** – Security beyond the firewall
- Summer: investing in **NGFW – Next Generation Firewall** to protect and block 99% of advanced online threats
  - **Cisco Talos** is the industry-leading threat intelligence organization dedicated to providing protection before, during, and after cybersecurity attacks.



## Consider moving into HCC Data Center @ SOCC


- With **HCC's Server Hosting** solution, you can be at the **State of Ohio Computer Center (SOCC)**, too.
