

USAEMSDB.....

Regarding question #1 - if you have not built or demolished any buildings, or made additions/modifications, yes, your square footage numbers from last year will be the same. Your percentages are in relation to student population. The percentages show how your total transportation and food service costs are allocated to each building, based on adm. Generally, there would be fluctuations in per building adm year to year that would affect these percentages.

Sometimes a significant change can take place.

For example, if you stopped bussing high school students, then transportation percentages for the high schools would be changed to 0 % and you would need to raise other building transportation percentages to equal 100% total.

VALACT.....

The OPU warnings you see on Valact can be ignored. Expenses charged on those codes where the OPU is 000 will be spread over the total school district. If that is what you want, then leave those codes as is. Where an OPU is included in the code, you may be receiving a warning because the OPU is tied to the district IRN instead of to a separate building IRN. Please review your OPU's on that question.

USASEMSED T.....

Your district's FEDSUM simply states that total Federal expenditures were at least \$750,000. That is the baseline standard. If in USAEMSED T you choose # 2 - Federal Assistance Programs - Summary, enter "c" to change, and then select #4. Total Federal Expenditures, you'll see a question to verify, yes or no, if your total Federal expenditures met that level for the fiscal year.
